Proposed Redistricting Would Affect Red Cedar Students and Families

East Lansing Schools Superintendent Dori Leyko announced at the October 22 school board meeting the District's plan to "right-size" East Lansing's elementary schools. To accomplish this, Red Cedar neighborhood school children (currently "Glencairn" students) would remain at Red Cedar in upcoming years as the students and administration of Pinecrest Elementary (and potentially Marble Elementary) cycle through the Red Cedar Elementary building as those buildings are being remodeled.



Many in the neighborhood have long sought and fought to have Red Cedar school reopened. At the same time, many families of school-aged children are concerned about the transition of having three (potentially four) administrations and student populations in three or four years. Little is known about the long-term future of Red Cedar Elementary's programming.
